The Return of the Black Rhino

Black rhinos once lived across large parts of Africa, but poaching and habitat loss caused their numbers to collapse. In some regions they disappeared completely. Conservationists in Zimbabwe have spent years trying to reverse that decline. (1) _____

Protecting rhinos requires far more than placing animals inside a reserve. Rangers patrol large areas, veterinary teams monitor health, and conservation groups work with nearby communities. (2) _____ Local support is especially important because wildlife protection must coexist with people's need for land and income.

Moving rhinos can also help rebuild populations. Carefully planned relocations place animals in secure habitats where there is enough food and space. (3) _____ Each move involves risk, so specialists consider age, health, genetics and the conditions at the destination.

Recent increases in some populations are encouraging, but conservationists remain cautious. Poaching has not disappeared, and a small population can still be vulnerable to disease or environmental change. (4) _____ Long-term success depends on protection continuing even after the headlines become positive.

A Cold Case Solved With DNA

Archaeologists studying human remains from the American Revolutionary War faced a difficult question: who was one of the young people buried at the site? Traditional records provided clues but no certain identity.

Researchers turned to genetic genealogy. DNA from the remains was compared with large numbers of genetic matches from living people. Instead of expecting one perfect match, specialists built family connections across many generations.

The investigation eventually pointed to a teenager who had joined the Continental Army in the eighteenth century.

Historical documents could then be compared with the genetic evidence, making the identification much stronger.

The case shows how archaeology is changing. Bones can reveal age and health, documents can provide names and dates, and DNA can connect the two. It also raises ethical questions about genetic databases and the privacy of living relatives, so researchers must use such methods carefully.
